

NOTICE OF RACE
PCCSC Team Race Conference Championship
Stanford University, Arrillaga Boathouse
May 3, 2015



RULES:

This regatta shall be governed by the current Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) including RRS Appendix D. RRS D2.2 and D2.3(b) shall be used (as changed by the ICSA Procedural and Class Rules), the ICSA Procedural Rules, ICSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, the PCCSC Standing Rules, and this Notice of Race, except as modified by the Sailing Instructions.

ORGANIZING AUTHORITY: The Organizing Authority (OA) is the Pacific Coast Collegiate Sailing Conference in conjunction with Stanford University.

VENUE: Redwood Creek, Redwood City, CA

BOATS: A fleet of 18 420z's will be provided for competitors, who shall not modify any boat or cause them to be modified in any way. Competitors have the option of rigging the mainsheet purchase either 3:1 or 4:1.

ELIGIBILITY: All PCCSC Regular or Provisional Member Schools in good standing are eligible to sail. A maximum of one (1) team per school will be allowed in the championship. As per the PCCSC Standing Rules, all competitors are required to wear their school pinnies. Sailors must meet all ICSA eligibility requirements and may be required to verify enrollment at the school they are representing.

ENTRY: Eligible teams must notify the host school and the Conference Commissioner five (5) days prior to the event with their intent to participate

ENTRY FEE: The entry fee for this event shall be \$150 payable to the PCCSC. Entry fees are due by the close of registration. Schools may call the PCCSC Office, 619-222-0252 to arrange payment by credit card.

FORMAT: The intended regatta format will be 2 round robins and a Final 4 to determine the overall champion. Win-Loss records for each team shall carry forward.

QUALIFICATION: This event shall serve as the PCCSC Qualifier for the ICSA Team Race National Championship. Eligible teams not planning to go on to the next level must declare so by 5pm the Monday after the championship so the next eligible team may be notified. Failure to do so shall result in sanctions by the PCCSC Executive Committee.

PROTESTS & APPEALS: In accordance with the ICSA Procedural Rules PR 38(c) the right of appeal is denied at all Conference Championships. Decisions of the Protest Committee shall be final.

SAFETY: A U.S. Coast Guard approved PFDs (Type III, minimum) shall be worn at all times on the water.

AWARDS: The winning team shall be awarded the PCCSC Conference Championship Carter Ford Trophy.

HOUSING: Teams are responsible for their own housing.
