**Rules**

This regatta shall be governed by the 2013-2016 Racing Rules of Sailing, ICOSA Procedural Rules, ICOSA Collegiate Dinghy Class Rules, PCCSC Standing Rules, and this Notice of Race.

**Eligibility and Entry**

This regatta will be a Coed-2-Division non-rotational event. Schools may enter as many teams as desired. All entrants must meet ICOSA eligibility requirements. **Teams shall confirm their participation online and with the host school by 0800 the Tuesday before.**

**Boats and Parking**

Bring your own. There are limited charters available at a fee of \$100 per weekend on a first come first serve basis. Trailer parking is available at the harbor. \$12 per day. There is limited free parking in the area, otherwise parking in the harbor is \$15 per day.

**Racing Area/Launching**

Racing will be conducted just outside the Monterey Harbor. Boats can be launched off the beach, or from the launch ramp in the harbor. Unless conditions dictate otherwise, rotations will take place off the beach.

## **Competitor's Meeting and Sailing Instructions**

The competitors meeting will be held at 10:00 a.m. on Saturday, March 14th outside the Monterey Peninsula Yacht Club. The Sailing Instructions will be available prior to the competitors' meeting and posted online.

## **Coaching**

All coaching should be done from the beaches. Any spectators on the water shall have no contact with any competitor except when rendering assistance under RRS Rule 1.1, or as instructed by the Race Committee. Coaches are not allowed on the water.

## **Housing**

Housing will not be provided. Contact Parker Smith for most cost effective options in the area.

## **Directions**

Take CA-1 to Del Monte Avenue (toward Pacific Grove)

Follow Del Monte Avenue until you reach Figueroa Street (you will see the beach and boatyard on the right)

Turn right onto Figueroa

This will take you into the harbor, the beach is on the right and the yacht club on the left at the beginning of the wharf. The launch ramp is in the parking lot to the left.

## **Safety**

U.S. Coast Guard approved PFDs (Type III minimum) must be worn at all times on the water.
